1) Audited Financial Statements

- a) John reviewed the function of the auditors
 - i) The auditor's responsibility is to express an independent, objective opinion on the financial statements of a company.
- **b)** Declared that Toquaht is in a positive financial position
- c) Went thru the Notes to the financial statements

- a) A new vessel was purchased through PICFI funding for Barkley Sound Shellfish harvesting

- c) The sawmill has been in use periodically over the year for Nation use
- d) The campground provided 2 full-time and 4 part-time jobs over the season

- **f)** The current Cut Control Period (CCP) for the forest licence is almost maxed out so cutting trees will slow down until the new CCP is negotiated
- **g)** The dryland sort will continue to be utilized by out side contracts over the rest of the cut control period
