# TOQUAHT NATION ADMINISTRATION GOOD GRADES ALLOWANCE POLICY



Purpose

To confirm who is eligible and how to receive the Toquaht Nation's Good Grades Allowance.

### **Scope**

This policy applies to Toquaht students, or the parents/guardians, applying for the Good Grades Allowance.

### **Overview**

The Good Grades Allowance is an incentive where Toquaht students in grades 1-12 can be rewarded by submitting their report cards throughout the academic school year (September – June). The Good Grades Allowance is to recognize Toquaht students *who do their best* in school, and who are committed to achieving good grades and a higher education.

Education is the key to a brighter future!

Report cards are reviewed and approved at the Administration office; a student will receive an allowance cheque in the mail or deposited to their bank account.

### Criteria

To be eligible for the Good Grades Allowance, all students must:

- ✓ Be an enrolled Citizen of the Toquaht Nation,
- ✓ Be in grades 1-12 during the academic school year (September June), and
- ✓ Maintain a minimum grade of a C.

Allowance cheques will be in the name of the student, regardless of age. The Toquaht Nation can also direct deposit the funds into your child's bank account.

### **Rates**

A student may receive increments of \$50/term to a maximum of four terms per year (e.g. SD70 Report card released: Nov, Feb, Apr, June).

If a student falls below a C- average, Toquaht Nation can offer tutoring fee assistance (and for students with disabilities, see additional info for parents below).

Tutoring Fees: Grade 1-7 \$10/hr

Grade 8-12 \$15/hr

## **How to Apply**

1) Ensure the Toquaht student meets the criteria laid out above.

- 2) The student or their parent or guardian <u>must submit a copy of their report card</u> to the Toquaht Nation office within 2 weeks of its receipt.

4) Once approved, the student will receive their allowance cheque from the Toquaht Nation within 2 weeks.

#### Additional Information for Parents or Guardians

- Students will not receive one lump sum at the end of the year.
- We encourage parents and guardians to open a bank account for your child and, using their Good Grades Allowance, help students understand the basics of banking and budgeting.
- Students with learning disabilities can request a letter from their teacher identifying their strengths and confirming they are working towards academic success and confidence.
