

ORDER OF THE HA?WIŁ

Re: State of Emergency on Toquaht Lands Extended

Enacted under the Emergency Preparedness Act section 2.4(a)

TNO 4/2020

BACKGROUND:

- A. Because of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, on March 30, 2020, pursuant to section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act, the ha?wił declared a state of emergency on all Toquaht lands which was extended on April 9, 2020; and
- B. The continuing risk of an outbreak of COVID-19 among the public remains a health hazard under the Emergency Preparedness Act.

NOW THEREFORE THE HA?WIŁ ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- Effective as of the date of this Order and pursuant to section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act, the ha?wił declares that a state of local emergency continues on all Toquaht lands;
- 2) The Executive's authority under section 3.4 of the Emergency Preparedness Act to implement response measures continues;
- 3) The authority of the director of operations and the director of lands, public works and resources to perform their duties and exercise their powers under sections 2.5 and 2.6 of the Emergency Preparedness Act, respectively, is continued;
- 4) Without limiting the directives issued in this Order, the Executive may at any time during the local state of emergency enable additional response measures in accordance with the Emergency Preparedness Act; and
- 5) This Order expires on April 23, 2020 and is subject to revision, cancellation or extension by the ha?wil in accordance with section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act.
