Position Summary

The Asset Manager reports to the Director of Assets and is responsible for coordinating and supervising the work of the asset team in the maintenance and repair of Toquaht infrastructure as well as physical assets (buildings, roads, fleet, machinery and equipment).

Major areas of Responsibilities

- Assist in the development and implementation of a GIS asset management system
- Oversee and coordinate contractors and staff to ensure the regular operations and maintenance of the existing assets
- Strategic and technical planning to execute multi-year projects with complex logistics and specific transport requirements to remote community
- Development of plans and strategies to ensure that the assets are functioning well and properly maintained.
- Assist with the budget process and analysis of variance reports
- Building and maintaining strong local partnerships to find increased efficiencies, innovative solutions and opportunities to respond to challenges within remote location
- Collaborate with partners and stakeholders where possible
- Ensure compliance to all relevant legislation and regulations, WorkSafe regulations, TNG Human Resources Policy, TNG Health & Safety Plan, Building Codes, Regulated inspection, and maintenance requirements etc.

Qualifications and Experience

- A post-secondary degree from a recognized university with specialization in engineering, project management, building trades, or a related discipline, or an acceptable combination of education, training and experience in a similar role.
- Experience in maintaining, operating and recapitalizing contemporary assets including buildings, roads, bridges, and municipal infrastructure including water and sewage treatment plants
- Knowledge of asset life cycle management principles, risk management and quality assurance principles, standards, best practices and techniques
- Ability to formulate strategic recommendations and solutions to senior management to guide asset management decision
- A minimum of 3 years of progressive leadership and supervisory experience
- Good oral, written communication and presentation skills

- Understanding of/respect for the culture and heritage of First Nations Peoples
- Always maintain confidentiality and professionalism
- This position spends most of the time located in Macoah
